As I write this article, it seems so easy now, SERVING LIFE IN PRISON - but when I got here I was a wreck and planning on taking my life. My addiction had brought me to the edge of my abyss. I was spiritually dead. "I am a 3-striker...when I get behind the wheel, I crash!"

I started reading the Bible and I thought, "No Way! I can't do this, it's too hard." But I kept reading the Bible and slowly, daily, weekly, month by month, God began to change me from the inside out. Some days are better than others. Now I start each day with prayer asking God to guide, protect, and use me to help others. Next I read the scriptures and my *Daily Bread*. Mentally, I put on "the armor of God". I remind myself that the battle I fight is spiritual, not physical. I try to give respect to everyone, including the officers. I look for ways to share Christ without being smug. I have the choice to do my time watching: 'Jerry Springer' OR 'READ THE WORD and fellowship with my bothers in Christ'. I choose to attend as many church services that are offered and sadly there are few....BUT I thank God for the ministry of the Chaplains and the support I get from the outside. SERVING LIFE BEHIND BARS, I AM MORE FREE THAN I HAVE EVER BEEN!!

OUR VISION

For Inmates to 'SEE'

When House of Hope first started at Kitsap County Jail, **there was no avenue for reading glasses to be given** to the inmates who <u>needed them!</u> We now provide glasses to the inmates! They may only receive one pair of glasses. We work with the Officers, as the giving of glasses is closely monitored. Every day we meet 10 - 15 <u>new inmates who request glasses</u>, so that they can 'read' their Bible and other books. We now give out more than 150 reading glasses every month!

If they don't have the glasses they need, they won't be able to read the Word of God!

House of Hope Looks to the Future

Transitional Living – "House of Faith" HoH began in 2008 and have always had a vision for a Men's Christian Discipleship House. House of Faith serves men who come from jail, prison, or other situations. They learn how to **truly change their lives by responding** to the **Spirit of the Lord**.
